COMBAT VEHICLE FIRE CONTROL SYSTEMS REAL FIRING FIELD TESTS

SCOPE

The purpose of this firing test procedure is to determine the hit probability of a complete combat vehicle system against well-defined reference targets. Tests are conducted under a variety of measurable and, if possible, reproducible conditions (e.g. combinations of modes, ranges, ammunition, courses, vehicles and targets).
