## ***LOGISTIC SUPPORT ANALYSIS RECORD (LSAR) REQUIREMENTS: STANDARD FOR***

### **INTRODUCTION**

#### **1. PURPOSE**

The successful implementation of a weapon system on CALMIS depends to a large degree on the successful transition of the weapon system from a non-CALMIS environment to the automated CALMIS environment, or from a weapon system without a controlled CALMIS baseline to a weapon system with a controlled baseline. The transition to the CALMIS environment implies (amongst others) the following:

- \* transition of correct and relevant management data to CALMIS;
- \* preparation of the weapon system operating and management environments to accept, support and use CALMIS;
- \* maintenance of the integrity of weapon system data after the initial transition;
- \* sustained and correct use of the CALMIS functionality.

This standard defines the minimum data requirements for the transition of a weapon system to CALMIS. In essence a “minimum” OBL (from a CALMIS data perspective) is established - refer to Figure 4 and the LSAR SDS for an overview.)

#### **2. SCOPE**

This standard is applicable to weapon systems with an LSAR under development for implementation on CALMIS as part of the operating baseline (OBL) of the weapon system.

The data requirements given in this standard are based on the CALMIS weapon system management functionality only. Weapon system transactional data are excluded from this standard.
